12.03.2026 Petition for bail filed U/S 482 B.N.S.S. on behalf of above named petitioner apprehending his arrest U/S 85 of B.N.S. in connection with Complaint Case No. 183/2025, pressed today for hearing.

Heard Sri Brahmdeo Prasad Yadav, learned lawyer for the petitioner and Sri Bibeka Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State.

In short, case of the complainant Anisa Khatoon is that she was married to petitioner Md. Sonu in the year-2017, and they have two children in the marriage. There is allegation of demand of dowry a cash of Rs. 2,00,000/- and due to non-fulfillment of additional dowry demand she was humiliated, assaulted and subjected to cruelty and removed from the matrimonial house. Then, the victim Anisa Khatoon along with her two children took shelter in the house of her parents.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is also submitted that the complainant, who was wedded wife of this petitioner but she has come in contact with another person, namely, Pawan Kumar and he is not ready to keep his wife with him. The allegations made by the complainant are totally concocted.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of complainant and the



learned P.P. appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner.

Both the complainant-wife and petitioner-husband are present in person before the court. But the petitioner-husband is not ready to keep his wife (complainant) with him.

Heard and perused the record. It appears that the Complaint Case No. 183/2025 has been filed by the complainant. It appears that two witnesses have been examined in inquiry, and on the basis of the evidences, cognizance has been taken and ordered to issue summon against the petitioner to face trial for offence U/S 85 of B.N.S. as per order dated-26.08.2025. It appears that only summon has been issued against the petitioner. As such, there is no apprehension of arrest the petitioner in the present case. Accordingly, it is, hereby, **disposed of.**

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned court below and the learned court below will pass appropriate order on the basis of the materials available on record without being prejudiced by this order.
