07.03.2026 Petition for regular bail filed on behalf of above named petitioner Chandan Kumar, who is in jail custody since-19.09.2025 in connection with Madhepura P.S. Case No. 744/2025 U/S 304(2) of B.N.S., pressed today for hearing.

Heard Sri Naresh Sharma, learned lawyer for the petitioner and Sri Bibeka Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State.

As per written-report of informant Bhawesh Kumar being Branch Manager of Micro Finance Company, Madhepura Branch, on 09.07.2025 at about 11:45 A.M., the informant was returning from Jhitkiya to Madhepura by his motorcycle (BR10AP5340). In the way, three miscreants riding on motorcycle (without number of plat) dashed motorcycle of informant from the backside, resulting in, the informant fell down and the miscreants looted away two mobile-phone (fitted SIM No. 9507159659 & 8976843528) as well as motorcycle, including purse contained Aadhar Card, Driving license, Debit card therein, and then, the miscreants fled away towards Laxminiya.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is also submitted that no incriminating article has been recovered from the house or possession of this petitioner. The petitioner is rotting in jail since-19.09.2025.

On the other hand, learned P.P. appearing on behalf of State strongly opposed the prayer for regular bail of petitioner as he with the

assistance of other co-accused persons have committed the alleged crime.

Perused the record. On perusal of case diary, it appears that the informant in his re-statement in para-2 has supported the case of prosecution. It also appears that the petitioner Chandan Kumar's name has been surfaced in the confessional statement of Kranti Kumar, which is evident from para-44 of case diary. Vide para-45 of case diary, the petitioner Chandan Kumar, in his confessional statement he has confessed his guilt before the police as he with the assistance of co-accused Kranti Kumar and Bijay Sharma committed the alleged crime. It also appears that the petitioner is not only the offender of the present case but he is involved in several criminal cases too, which is evident from para-66 of case diary in which 03 criminal cases have been shown against him such as road-robbery, Arms Act, attempt to murder. It also appears that after thorough investigation the charge-sheet has been submitted by the police finding the case true U/S 304(2) of B.N.S. against this petitioner (vide para-98). Allegation against the petitioner prima-facie appears to be serious one. Such type of crime is rampant in Kosi region.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the materials available on record, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail for the present. Accordingly, bail petition filed on behalf of above named accused-petitioner is, hereby, **rejected**.

However, the petitioner may renew his prayer for regular bail before the learned court below after deposition of informant of the present case.
