**18.03.2026** Petition for bail filed U/s 482 B.N.S.S. on behalf of above named petitioner apprehending his arrest U/Ss. 316(2), 318(4) of B.N.S. in connection with Madhepura P.S. Case No. 897/2025, pressed today for hearing.

Heard Sri Nishant Kumar, learned lawyer for the petitioner as well as Sri Chandra Kant Jha, learned lawyer for the informant and Bibeka Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State.

According to First Information Report, allegation is about execution of an agreement to sell a building in a sum of Rs. 29,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty-Nine Lakh) by Nutan Singh (petitioner) with the informant Mahadeo Pandit on 01.02.2025. It is said that out of a total Rs. 29,00,000/-, Rs. 10,00,000/- was being made payment by the informant to accused persons in that respect but neither registered the said building in the name of informant nor returned the amount aforesaid.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent lady and she has falsely been implicated in the present case. As a matter of fact the total amount has already been returned by the petitioner to informant in a panchayati held in this regard and no receipt was given to petitioner on that very time. The petitioner is lady and she has not committed any criminal act in any way. It is also submitted that co-accused Nigam Raj has already been granted regular bail by the court of learned C.J.M., Madhepura as per order dated-22.01.2026.



Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of informant opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner and learned P.P. appearing on behalf of State conceded that earlier co-accused person has already been granted bail by the learned court below and the matter is of civil nature mainly.

Perused the record. Allegation is of committing fraud by the accused persons, including the petitioner but no investigation in this regard has been pointedly out so far as per case diary. From the record, it also appears that after thorough hearing and perusing the case diary, co-accused Nigam Raj has already been granted regular bail by the court of learned C.J.M., Madhepura vide order dated-22.01.2026. It appears to be a case of civil dispute mainly between the parties. The petitioner is a lady having a clean antecedent, which is evident from para-30 & 31 of case diary.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case and after hearing the parties and especially keeping in view of lady petitioner, she is directed to be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within 15 days from the date of receipt a copy of this order/ production before the learned court below, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below in connection with Madhepura P.S. Case No. 897/2025, subject to condition as laid down u/s 482(2) of B.N.S.S., with condition that the petitioner shall execute undertaking that she shall cooperate in investigation and trial.
