

**In the Court of Sessions Judge, Madhepura.****A.B.P. No. 203/2026****(Arising out of Murliganj P.S. Case No. 25/2026).**

**12.03.2026** Petition for bail filed U/s 482 B.N.S.S. on behalf of above named petitioner apprehending his arrest U/Ss. 126(2), 115(2), 110, 3(5) of B.N.S. in connection with Murliganj P.S. Case No. 25/2026, pressed today for hearing.

Heard Sri Awadh Kishore Yadav, learned lawyer for the petitioner and Sri Bibeka Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State.

As per written-report of informant Bipin Kumar Sharma, allegation is that the petitioner Ashish Kumar and co-accused Bikram Kumar assaulted the informant with Lathi, fists and slaps. Further allegation is that co-accused Bikram Kumar assaulted the informant with the Butt-of-Katta causing injury at his lip. Previous enmity is alleged as reason for the occurrence.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is also submitted that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner rather general and omnibus. Moreover, the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent at all.

Learned P.P. appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner.

Perused the record. On perusal of case diary, it appears that the informant in his re-statement in para-2 has supported the case of prosecution. Apart from this, the witnesses examined in para-5, 6 & 8 have also supported the prosecution case. From perusal of injury-report, it appears that the doctor



has found one simple slight swelling on lower lip of injured Bipin Kumar Sharma (vide para-15). Presently, the investigation is still going on (vide para-17).

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case as discussed above, in my view, this is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner. Therefore, the above named petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned court below and seek regular bail. Accordingly, anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of above named petitioner is, hereby, **disposed of.**

The learned court below shall consider the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner without being prejudiced by this order and also considering the factum of injury of injured as doctor has found simple injury on the person of injured.
