A regular bail petition filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Mukesh Kumar Mehta, who is in custody since 08.08.2025 in connection with Alamnagar P.S. Case No.- 430 of 2024, u/s- 103(1), 3(5) of the BNS & 27 Arms Act, has been pressed today for hearing. Copy of petition already been served to learned A.P.P for the state.

Heard Sri C.D. Singh, learned lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Sri Jai Narayan Pandit, A.P.P. for the state and perused the case record.

As per written-report of informant Kiran Devi, allegation is that on 01.11.2024 at about 11:30 hours in the night, the informant along with her husband Ramchandra Mehta were sleeping inside the room. At the same time, the accused persons including the petitioner Mukesh Kumar Mehta having Arms came at the door by breaking the lock of main door and got up the informant and her husband by them, and thereafter, co-accused Sanjeev Kumar Mehta shot bullet hitting right side of chest of Ramchandra Mehta, and subsequently, petitioner Mukesh Kumar Mehta shot bullet hitting below the chest of Ramchandra Mehta, as a result whereof, the informant's husband Ramchandra Mehta succumbed on the spot. After this, the accused persons fled away by giving threatening the informant to dire consequence, if the case is lodged against them.

Ld advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that no anticipatory or regular bail petitioner earlier filed before this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna except the present prayer. Petitioner has got two criminal antecedent. Petitioner is in custody since 08.08.2025. Petitioner is quite innocent and he has not committed any offence. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to land dispute at the behest of his enemy, who had gone to Khagaria district to see his sister who was ill. The informant has not given any details as to who she identified the face of any accused despite it being dark at night. Petitioner is ready to give

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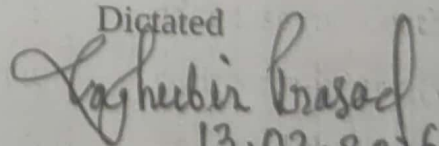
sound sureties to the satisfaction of the court. It is therefore, humbly prayed that the petitioner is enlarge on bail.

The ld A.P.P. Sri Jai Narayan Pandit vehemently opposed the prayer of bail and prayed to reject the same.

Heard both sides and perused the case-record. On perusal it is evident from the record that the FIR was registered u/s.- 103(1), 3(5) of the BNS & 27 Arms Act. Petitioner is named in the FIR. It further appears that the informant in her re-statement in para-7 has fully supported the version of the written-report. It also appears that the witnesses examined in para-8, 9 & 10 have also supported the prosecution case. According to P.M.R., the doctor has opined cause of death of deceased Ramchandra Mehta - Shock and Haemorrhage due to firearm-injury (vide para-91). It also appears that during investigation the police have found the case true U/Ss. 103(1), 3(5) B.N.S. & 27 of Arms Act against the petitioner Mukesh Kumar Mehta and 02 others (vide para-67). The involvement of this petitioner reveals in commission of murder of the deceased. The offence is very serious one.

In light of the above facts and circumstances and taking into account the seriousness of the offence, this court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, prayer for regular bail of this petitioner namely, Mukesh Kumar Mehta in connection with Alamnagar P.S. Case No. 430 of 2024 is hereby, rejected.
