09.03.2026 Petition for regular bail filed on behalf of above named petitioner, who is in jail custody since-23.12.2025 in connection with Madhepura P.S. Case No. 1230/2025 U/Ss. 115(2), 126(2), 85, 109, 352, 3(5) of B.N.S. & 3/5 D.P. Act, pressed today for hearing.

Heard Sri Bibhishan Prasad Yadav, learned lawyer for the petitioner as well as Sri Satyendra Kumar Mishra, learned lawyer for the informant and Sri Bibeka Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State.

In short, case of the informant Nitu Kumari is that she was married to petitioner Nikhil Kumar in the year-2023, and she gave birth to one boy child from their wedlock. There is allegation of demand of one four-wheeler vehicle and due to non-fulfillment of the same, she was being tortured, assaulted and subjected to cruelty by her in-laws and husband.

Perused the record. It appears that the petitioner is husband and he is in custody since-23.12.2025. It appears that this is a case U/Ss. 85, 109 & other Sections of B.N.S. & 3/5 D.P. Act. The petitioner Nikhil Kumar (husband), who produced from jail and the informant (wife) also appeared in court and both the spouse became ready to live together as the petitioner-husband admitted that he will keep his wife (informant)

and child with full-honour and dignity and he will provide Rs. 8000/- (Rupees Eight Thousand) per month to his wife (informant) for her expense and maintenance. The informant-wife admitted before the court that she is ready to live with her husband, if her husband (petitioner) keeps her child and her with him with full-honour and dignity and provides Rs. 8000/- (Rupees Eight Thousand) per month to her for personal expense and maintenance. She also admitted that she will perform her wife-duty promptly at her Sasural. The compromise petition with permission petition duly signed by both the parties has been filed.

Considering the aforesaid facts, prayer of above named petitioner is **allowed** and he is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below in connection with Madhepura P.S. Case No. 1230/2025, **with condition that the prosecution is at liberty to file the petition for cancellation of bail of petitioner before the concerned court, if he shall not fulfill the terms and conditions of the compromise petition as contained therein.**
