

In the Court of Sessions Judge, Madhepura.**B.P. No. 174/2026****(Arising out of Alamnagar P.S. Case No. 190/2025).**

12.03.2026 Petition for regular bail filed on behalf of above named petitioner, who is in jail custody since-14.06.2025 in connection with Alamnagar P.S. Case No. 190/2025 U/Ss. 329(4), 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 75, 352, 351, (2), 3(5) of B.N.S., pressed today for hearing.

Heard Sri Kumar Chandra Shekhar, learned lawyer for the petitioner as well as Sri Chandra Deo Singh, learned lawyer for the informant and Sri Bibeka Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State.

As per written-report of informant Prabhat Kumar, co-accused Arun Kumar and Abha Devi are alleged to have assaulted with Dabiya causing injury at the right-hand and arm of informant's wife Neelam Devi. Petitioner Hemant Kumar assaulted with sharp-edged weapon (Dabiya) causing injury at the head of informant's wife Neelam Devi.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that due to land dispute between the parties, the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner is in custody since-14.06.2025, and he has got no criminal antecedent at all. It also appears that prayer of co-accused Arun Kumar has already been granted regular bail by this learned court vide order dated-25.09.2025 passed in B.P. No. 2131/2025, and the case of this petitioner stands on similar footing.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of informant and learned P.P. appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for regular bail of petitioner.

Perused the record. Land dispute is apparent between the parties. From perusal of injury-report-2, it appears that the doctor has found mostly

simple injury except injury No. 5 on the person of injured Neelam Devi (vide para-7 of supplementary case diary). It also appears that in fact the charge-sheet has already been submitted against this petitioner by the police in the case (vide para-50 of original case diary). The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent, which is evident from para-46 of case diary. It also appears that co-accused Arun Kumar has already been granted regular bail by this court in B.P. No. 2131/2025. He is in custody since-14.06.2025, and he is also entitled to parity.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the allegation levelled against the petitioner as well as reason for the occurrence and also considering the custody undergone by the petitioner since-14.06.2025, he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below in connection with Alamnagar P.S. Case No. 190/2025, with condition that (i) one of the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner and (ii) the petitioner shall remain physically present before the court on each and every date till trial of this case, failing to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail bonds shall automatically be cancelled.
