29/04/26	Pankaj Sah, S/o.- Late Lakhan Lal Sah, R/o.- Basanbara Navgachhiya Basa, Ward No.- 05, P.S.- Alamnagar, Dist-Madhepura..... Petitioner. Vs. State of Bihar O.P. A regular bail petition filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Pankaj Sah, who is in custody since 10.02.2026 in connection with Alamnagar P.S. Case No.- 28 of 2026, u/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(2), 74, 303(2), 109(1), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS, has been pressed today for hearing. Copy of petition already been served to learned A.P.P for the state. Heard Sri. Palat Pd. Yadav, learned lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Sri Jai Narayan Pandit, A.P.P. for the state and perused the case record. As per typed-report of informant Pooja Kumari, is that on 08.02.2026, between 4 and 5 pm, her husband, Vinay Kumar, a rural doctor by profession, treats people in his village and the surrounding rural areas. As her husband was leaving his home to see a patient, he encountered Pankaj Sah near his doorstep. As soon as he demanded his money, Pankaj Sah began to behave rudely and beat him. As soon as she got the information that her husband was being brutally beaten by Pankaj Sah, Bindeshwari Sah, Aashiq Kumar & Babita Devi, all of them were carrying dabiya, axes, iron rods, sharp knives, lathi etc. in their hands. As soon as she ran towards them to save her husband, Pankaj Sah caught hold of her forehead hair from behind, lifted her up and threw her on the ground, due to which her modesty was violated and as soon as she was thrown on the ground, Aashiq Kumar started beating her with kicks, punches and punches on her chest and soft parts of the body. Bindeshwari Shah ordered petitioner Pankaj Shah, what are you waiting for, kill this bastard today, let's see who comes to save these people. On hearing this, petitioner Pankaj Sha, with the intention of killing him, stabbed him hard on the left side of his stomach with a sharp knife in his hand, which got embedded in his stomach, due to which he fell on the ground and was covered in blood. Meanwhile, Aashiq Kumar, with the intention of killing her father-in-law Yogendra Sha, who had come to save us, attacked him hard on his left hand with a sharp knife. Due to which her father-in-law's hand also got cut and he fell on the ground covered in blood. Petitioner Pankaj Sha, her husband, Vinay Kumar, began beating him with an iron rod, breaking both of his arms and falling to the ground. Meanwhile, Babita Devi, came up to her and snatched her gold mangalsutra, weighing about one bhar, and an eight-anna earring from her neck and ran away. Ld advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that no anticipatory or regular bail petitioner earlier filed before this court or Hon'ble High	
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<u>29/04/26</u> Contd...	Court, Patna except the present prayer. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Petitioner is in custody since 10.02.2026. Regular bail of the petitioner has been rejected by lower court on 18.02.2026. Petitioner is quite innocent and he has not committed any offence. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. Petitioner is ready to give sound sureties to the satisfaction of the court. It is therefore, humbly prayed that the petitioner is enlarge on bail. The ld A.P.P. Sri Jai Narayan Pandit, vehemently opposed the bail and prayed to reject the same. Heard both sides and perused the case record as well as xerox copy of case-diary. From perusal of case record it is evident that the case lodge u/s.- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(2), 74, 303(2), 109(1), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS. Petitioner is named in the FIR. On perusal of case-diary it is evident that the informant in his re-statement in para-2, witnesses in para-06, 07, 06 has fully supported the version of the written-report. As per injury report of injured all injury are simple in nature. Petitioner is in custody since 10.02.2026. Considering the above facts and circumstances and taking into account the nature of allegation against the petitioner and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner in jail, prayer of above named petitioner is allowed he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned court below in connection with Alamnagar P.S. Case No.- 28 of 2026 with condition that:- (1) One of the bailor shall be close relative of the petitioner.
