ORDER

This application for regular bail filed under Section 483 of the BNSS on behalf of the petitioner Md. Saddam, who is in custody since 23.12.2025 in connection with Srinagar P.S. Case No. 120 of 2025 u/s. 303 (2) of the BNS, is pressed today for hearing.

Heard Sri C.P. Chandan, learned Chief LADCS, Madhepura, appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Sri Bibeka Kumar Singh, learned P.P. on behalf of the State of Bihar.

It is alleged in the First Information Report by the informant Amin Alam that on 17.12.2025 at about 09.00 o'clock the informant after meeting with the Amin for measurement of the land returned to his house at Mangwara Rahta from Puraini Karriya by his motorcycle bearing registration No. BR43S 2419 and after parking his motorcycle in the courtyard and having taken meal he slept. When the informant woke up in the morning he found that his motorcycle was found missing from the courtyard. The informant searched the motor-cycle at his own level but nothing could be traced out.

Learned Chief LADCS appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics and groupism in collusion with the police in order to harass and humiliate him in the society. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent prior to this case. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner. The petitioner is in jail since 23.12.2025.

The learned P.P. appearing on behalf of the State of Bihar opposed the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

Perused the record of this regular bail application coupled with the case diary. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. As per paragraph - 14 of the case diary it



appears that the stolen motorcycle has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. As per paragraph – 19 of the case diary it appears that the petitioner Md. Saddam has confessed his involvement in the alleged occurrence. As per paragraph – 75 of the case diary it appears that charge-sheet has already been submitted against the petitioner and co-accused Md. Arshad for the offence u/ss., 302 (2) and 317 (2) of the B.N.S. vide charge-sheet No. 28 of 2026 dated 14.02.2026. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.12.2025.

Considering the above facts, circumstances of the case as well as considering the period of detention of the petitioner in custody since 23.12.2025, the petitioner Md. Saddam is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower court in connection with Srinagar P.S. Case No. 120 of 2025 with conditions that (1) one of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioner, (2) the petitioner shall not be indulged again in similar nature of offence in future and if he indulges again in similar nature of offence, his bail bond shall be cancelled automatically and (3) the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on each and every date till the conclusion of the trial and if he failed to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail bond shall be cancelled automatically. **The bail bond of the petitioner Md. Saddam shall be filed and accepted after framing of the charge in this case.**
