18.04.2026 Petition for regular bail filed on behalf of above named petitioner, who is in jail custody since-15.02.2026 in connection with Fulaut P.S. Case No. 06/2025 U/Ss. 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(3), 109(2), 303(2) of B.N.S. & 27 of Arms Act, pressed today for hearing.

Heard Sri Jay Prakash Ram, learned lawyer for the petitioner and Sri Bibeka Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State.

As per Fard-beyan of informant Birendra Yadav, on 16.04.2025 at about 09:00 hours in the night, some persons were firing crackers in front of the house of informant of which the informant forbade them. For this reason, the accused persons, including the petitioners and 20-25 unknown persons variously armed with Lathi-danda came and started abusing. When the informant forbade them from using abusive words, the accused persons encircled the informant and assaulted with Lathi causing injury at his head. When the informant's family members Lalo Yadav, Kanhaiya Yadav, Pappu Yadav, Bhutto Yadav, Khuto Yadav, Soni Devi came to save the informant, they were also assaulted by the accused persons. There is also allegation of snatching a cash of Rs. 5000/- from the pocket of informant by petitioner Balmiki Chaudhary and also gold-chain and earring from the Bhawo of informant by co-accused Bikash Chaudhary.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in the present case in order to save the skin from the Fulaut P.S. Case No. 05/2025. It is also submitted that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner

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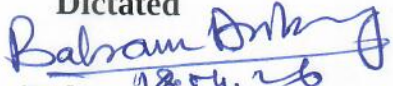
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and the allegation of theft is ornamental. The petitioner is in jail custody since-15.02.2026, and he has got no criminal antecedent at all. It is also submitted that co-accused Ganesh Chaudhary has already been granted regular bail by this learned court vide order dated-11.12.2025 passed in B.P. No. 2368/2025, and the case of this petitioner stands on similar footing.

Learned P.P. appearing on behalf of State conceded the said prayer and submissions of learned defence counsel.

Perused the record. It appears that there is case and counter case between the parties. It also appears that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner. From perusal of injury-report enclosed with the case diary, it appears that the doctor has found the injury on the person of injured – all simple in nature caused by hard and blunt object. It also appears that co-accused Ganesh Chaudhary has already been granted regular bail by this court in B.P. No. 2368/2025. The petitioner is in custody since-15.02.2026, and he is also entitled to parity.

In view of aforesaid facts, prayer of above named petitioner is **allowed** too and he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below in connection with Fulaut P.S. Case No. 06/2025.
