06.05.2026 Petition for regular bail filed on behalf of above named petitioner, who is in jail custody since-18.02.2026 in connection with Bihariganj P.S. Case No. 303/2024 U/Ss. 310(4), 310(5) of B.N.S. & U/Ss. 25(1-B)a, 26, 35 of Arms Act, pressed today for hearing.

Heard Sri Shyamanand Mishra, learned lawyer for the petitioner and Sri Bibeka Kumar Singh, learned P.P. for the State.

According to First Information Report, when the Bihariganj police raided the information place, six motorcycle borne persons riding on two motorcycle, seeing the police, attempted to flee away, in course of which, three persons were caught hold by the police on chase, whereas three persons managed to escape by motorcycle. On query, the apprehended persons disclosed their names as Sumit Kumar, Prashant Kumar & Aman Kumar. On search, one knife recovered from the possession of co-accused Sumit Kumar by the police, whereas one country-made pistol and two live-cartridge and two empty-cartridges also recovered from the possession of co-accused Prashant Kumar and one knife from the possession of co-accused Aman Kumar. The apprehended persons also stated the names of that persons, who managed to escape from the spot as Prince Kumar S/o Mantu Yadav, Aryan Kumar (petitioner) and Prince Kumar S/o Pramod Yadav.

Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. No incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner. The petitioner is languishing in jail since-18.02.2026, and he has

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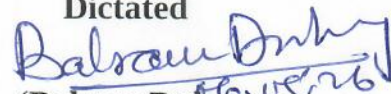
sufficiently been punished for the allegation levelled against him.

Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer for regular bail of petitioner.

Perused the record. It appears that the petitioner was not arrested by the police on spot rather his name was surfaced by the apprehended persons. It also appears that co-accused Sumit Kumar has already been granted regular bail by this court by the then learned Sessions Judge, Madhepura in B.P. No. 2397/2024. The petitioner is in judicial custody since-18.02.2026, and he is also entitled to parity.

Considering the facts and circumstance of the case as discussed above and also considering the custody undergone by the petitioner, he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below in connection with Bihariganj P.S. Case No. 303/2024, with condition that (1) one of the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner, (2) he would not indulge again in similar nature of case, and if, he involves in same nature of case in future, his bail bonds shall automatically be cancelled and (3) the petitioner shall remain physically present before the court on each and every date till disposal of this case, failing to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail bonds shall automatically be cancelled. ***The bail bonds of above named petitioner shall be filed and accepted after framing of charge in the case.***
