

**In the court of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Udakishunganj.**  
**Chousa P.S Case No. 92 of 2020.**  
**G.R No.- 339 of 2020.**

A bail petition filed through e-filing on behalf of the petitioner, namely, Jaykant Singh, who is in custody since 30.06.2021, is put up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Heard both sides.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is quite innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this concocted case due to village politics and also, because the petitioner failed to meet the greedy demand of the local police. The petitioner had earlier filed A.B.P. No. 363/2021 in the Court of Ld. Sessions Judge, Madhepura, but, the same was withdrawn. This apart, no bail application has been either filed or is pending in any court. No case u/s. 307, 354 & 397 IPC stands made out against the petitioner as the allegation is not specific, rather, general in nature. The stolen golden chain has not been recovered. There is counter-case bearing Chousa P.S. Case No. 93/2020 as well. The petitioner is a rustic and poor person who earns his income through hard work. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedents and he is in custody since 30.06.2021, hence, he may kindly be released on bail.

Learned A.P.O. strongly opposed the prayer of the petitioner for bail.

Perused the F.I.R., case-record as well as the case-diary. It appears that the F.I.R. has been registered for the offences punishable u/ss. 447, 341, 323, 307, 354, 379, 504, 506/34 I.P.C. The petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and allegation against him is that he in association with other co-accused persons assaulted the informant and his family members and caused injuries to them. In this occurrence several persons received injuries, including head-injury to one person. The case is under investigation.

Considering the serious nature of offence committed u/s. 307 IPC., I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petition for bail of the above-named petitioner is hereby rejected.
