Today, the complainant has filed a petition seeking permission to withdraw the present complaint case. The petition is taken up for consideration. Heard the complainant and her learned counsel. The complainant has stated in her petition that she has amicably settled the dispute with the accused person(s) and does not wish to pursue the complaint any further.
