- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Nitu Kumari, W/o- Ajay Rai.
- (2) The petitioner is seeking per-arrest bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS, in Gaighat P.S. Case No. 298/2025 registered under sections 191(2),190,126(2),115(2),118(1),117(1),118(2),109,352,351(2),351(3) of BNS.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent. The entire allegation levelled against the petitioner is false and concocted.
- (5) The case of the informant Renu Devi is that on 14.12.2025 around 6 PM, her sisters-in-law called saying that her husband and his family members were trying to throw her out of the house. On hearing the news, she along with her sisters-in-law and son went there only to find her, sisters-in-law being assaulted and the accused trying to throw her out. When she objected to that, the accused abused and assaulted them.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.
- (7) Perused the case diary including the injury of the informant Renu Devi, wherein she is reported to have received the lacerated wound on the abdomen by the sharp object, however the nature of injury is not mentioned.

(8) Taking into account the above facts and circumstances and nature of allegation against the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner is first time offender and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of her arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order let the petitioner, namely Nitu Kumari, W/o- Ajay Rai be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court subject to the following conditions:-

- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigation agency, as and when required.
- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
