ORDER

The above named petitioners seeks “Anticipatory Bail” in connection with **Fakuli PS Case No. 88/2025** for offences punishable u/ss 191(2), 318(2), 316(2), 115(2), 118(1), 126(2), 303(2), 109, 76, 61(2), 309(4), 354 of the BNS due to apprehension of their arrest in this case. Copy of the same to be served to Ld. Addl.P.P. on behalf of State.
2. Today, on behalf of the petitioners, no one can appear before the court at the time of hearing. On the other side, learned Addl. P.P. has submitted that the petitioner already bail out by the concerned P.S. in the light of section 35(3) of the BNSS. Therefore, the court may be passed order accordingly.
3. Having considered the submission made by the Ld. Addl. P.P. and from perusal of the case diary para 25, it appears that the petitioners already got privilege of section 35(3) of BNSS, so in such circumstances there is no matter for anticipatory bail of the petitioners. Therefore, the anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner is hereby **rejected**.
