- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused 1. Rambabu Mahto, S/o- Ramvilash Mahto and 2. Pankaj Kumar, S/o- Shivnath Mahto.
- (2) The Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS apprehending their arrest in Complaint Case (E) No. 774 of 2020, registered under sections 323, 452, 504, 506 of IPC.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioners submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) Ld. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that petitioners are innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner no. 2 has got one criminal antecedent in which he is on bail. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is false, fabricated and concocted.
- (5) The case of the informant is that when the informant returned from the court on 13.02.2020, she was being abused by the accused and threatened not to give evidence in that case. When she objected, she was being assaulted by the accused persons.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.
- (7) Looking at the nature of allegations against the petitioners and the fact that no injury report is available on the record and also the fact that no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence or would influence the investigation in any manner, if released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioners namely, 1. Rambabu Mahto, S/o- Ramvilash Mahto and 2. Pankaj Kumar, S/o- Shivnath Mahto be released on furnishing a bail bond of

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Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned, subject to following conditions:-

- The petitioners shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
