- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused 1. Md. Irshad, S/o- Md. Anwar Raine.
- (2) The Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS apprehending his arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 1424 of 2024, registered under sections 323, 504, 506, 498(A) of IPC.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is false and concocted.
- (5) Both parties are present along with their respective learned counsels. The petitioner is ready to pay his wife (complainant) a monthly sum of Rs. 3,000/- as maintenance for her as well as for her children. He also submits that complainant was the wife of his elder brother and after his demise, he was forced to marry her but still he managed to take care of her and her children. The complainant agrees to the same and submits that she would be staying at his house and will take care of his parents also.
- (6) In light of the submissions made by the parties and the fact that petitioner is first time offender and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioner namely, 1. Md. Irshad, S/o- Md. Anwar Raine be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the

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like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to following conditions:

- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
