- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused 1.Pramod Sah @ Ram Prabodh Sah, S/o- Late Ram Ashish Sah, 2. Arjun Sah @ Anush Kumar, S/o- Ram Pravesh Sah @ Pramod Sah, 3. Jay Kumar Sah @ Jayava Sah, S/o- Ramprabodh Sah @ Pramod Sah, 4. Aman Kumar, S/o- Ram Pramod @ Sah Pramod Sah, 5. Mangla Nand Singh, S/o- Late Chandrika Prasad Singh, 6. Chandmani Singh @ Radhey Krishan, 7. Gopal Singh @ Gopal Krishna, 8. Govind Singh @ Govind Krishna (petitioner no. 6 to 8 are sons of Mangla Nand Singh), 9 Tonu Singh @ Arvind Singh and 10. Bhonu Singh @ Kaushal Kishor Singh (petitioner no. 9 and 10 are sons of Kala Nand Singh.)
- (2) The petitioners are apprehending their arrest under section 482(2) of the BNSS, in connection with Aurai PS Case No. 42/2026, registered under sections 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 74, 352, 351(2) of the BNS.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioners submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved either before this court or the Hon'ble High Court, Patna.
- (4) The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that they are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that the allegation levelled against the petitioners is false and concocted and they do not have any criminal antecedent.
- (5) The case of the informant Rambabu Sah is that when he went to the accused asking for his due amount Rs. 200/-, he was being assaulted by them. Mangla Nand Singh assaulted his father with a rod injuring his head. When his mother came to save him, she too was assaulted and in the process, Rs. 10,000/- was taken out from his father's pocket and mangalsutra was also taken away.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioners.
- (7) Looking at the nature of allegations against the petitioners except petitioner no. 5 Mangla Nand Singh, are general and composite in nature and also the fact that petitioners are first time offenders and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar

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offence, if released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks period from the date of communication of this order, let the above named petitioners except petitioner no. 5 (Mangla Nand Singh) be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court subject to the following conditions:-

- The petitioners shall co-operate with the investigation agency, as and when required.
- The petitioners shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.

As for petitioner no. 5 Mangla Nand Singh, the prosecution is directed to produce injury report by the next date. In the meantime, no coercive step shall be taken against the petitioner.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the concerned trial court and PS for the needful. Put up on 26.03.2026 for hearing.
