This application has been filed, for grant of anticipatory bail, on behalf of the accused petitioner namely, Raja Kumar, in connection with Sakra P.S. Case no. 462/2025, registered U/Ss 76 of the B.N.S. and 66(E) of the IT Act, pending in the Ld. Court of A.C.J.M. 15th Muzaffarpur (East).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner, has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions of any nature, had been filed by the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got no criminal history. That the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. That the petitioner is owner of mobile no. 9547304079 and except that there is no allegation of misuse of mobile by him. That other co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail application vide A.B.P. No. 4254/2025, by the court. That the allegations as levelled against the petitioner are vague, general and omnibus in nature and they are not specific against the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner has got genuine apprehension of his arrest in this case. Ld. counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on anticipatory bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the record, including the FIR. From perusal of record, it transpires that FIR was lodged against the owners/possessors of some mobile numbers. The petitioner is not named in the FIR and allegations against the petitioner is that he had made video calling and had obtained obscene photograph of the informant, had put them on social media and had also threatened her and demanded ransom from her. Further, the allegations appear to be vague, general and omnibus in nature and the allegations are not specific, against the petitioner, rather they are common. Some co-accused persons have

been admitted to the privilege of anticipatory bail by the court and case for bail of this petitioner stands on similar footing. As per para no. 03 of the anticipatory bail application, petitioner has got no criminal history.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including nature of allegations against the petitioner, the prayer for anticipatory bail, in respect of him, is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, the accused petitioner, namely, **Raja Kumar**, is directed to be released on anticipatory bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousands) with two sureties of the like amount, subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
