

In the Court Of 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Muzaffarpur**A.B.P No. 936/2026****Chiku Kumar..... Petitioner.****Vs.****State of Bihar.....O.P.****O R D E R****18.03.2026**

This application has been filed, for grant of anticipatory bail, on behalf of the accused petitioner, namely, Chiku Kumar, in connection with Bochaha P.S. Case No. 300/2025, registered U/Ss 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3) of the B.N.S., pending in the Ld. Court of A.C.J.M. 9th, Muzaffarpur (East).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner, has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions of any nature, had been filed by the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got no criminal history. That the petitioner is quite innocent, has not committed any offence and has falsely been implicated in this case, due to dirty village politics. That no such offence is made out against the petitioner, as alleged in the FIR. That entire prosecution story is false and concocted. That all the sections are bailable in nature, except offence u/s 303(2) of the BNS, which is not specific against the petitioner. It has further been submitted that the petitioner has got genuine apprehension of his arrest in this case. Ld. counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on anticipatory bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the record, including the F.I.R. From perusal of the record, it transpires that allegations against the petitioner are general, vague and omnibus in nature. The allegations mainly relate to use of filthy language and scuffle. There is no any specific allegation against the petitioner and no specific overt act has been attributed to him, regarding assault on any vital part of body of the informant. The petitioner has got no criminal history, as per para no. 03 of the anticipatory bail application.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, the prayer for anticipatory bail, in respect of the petitioner, is hereby **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, the accused petitioner, namely, **Chiku Kumar**, is directed to be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousands) with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below and subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
