**O R D E R**

This application has been filed, on behalf of the accused petitioner in custody, namely, Aman Kumar, for grant of regular bail, in connection with Kanti P.S. Case no. 571/2025, registered u/s 309(4) of the B.N.S., pending in the Ld. Court of A.C.J.M. 1<sup>st</sup>, Muzaffarpur (West).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner, has submitted that earlier, petitioner had filed one anticipatory bail application, before the court and the same was dismissed as withdrawn, as the petitioner was arrested in the meanwhile and except that petition, no other anticipatory or regular bail petitions, of any nature had been filed by the the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got no criminal history. That the petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed any offence. That the FIR has been filed against unknown, by the informant. That the petitioner is not named in the FIR and nothing has been recovered from his possession. That the petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 17.02.2026. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the original record, including the FIR and Suppl. case diary, from paras no. 01 to 12. From perusal of the record, it transpires that petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name has surfaced in this case, his own confessional statement, recorded by the police. As per the search and seizure memo, cash amount of Rs. 25,000/-, one mobile phone, shoes and motorcycle have been recovered from other co-accused persons. Nothing has been recovered from conscious possession of this petitioner. No TIP has been conducted and no CCTV footage of the alleged occurrence, is available on record, showing complicity of this petitioner, in this case. Other co-accused

persons have already been granted regular bail and case for bail of the petitioner, stands on better footing. The petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 17.02.2026 and he has got no criminal history, as per par no. 03 of the bail petition.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including period of jail custody, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, bail application of the accused petitioner, namely, **Aman Kumar**, stands **allowed** and he is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
