- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Md. Shamsheer Kureshi, S/o- Md. Kamruddin @ Mahajan Kureshi.
- (2) The petitioner is seeking per-arrest bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS, in Sadar P.S. Case No. 51/2026, registered under section 303(2) of BNS.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent. The entire allegation levelled against the petitioner is false and concocted.
- (5) The case of the informant Virchandra Ray is that on 17.01.2026 around 12 in the night, he found that out of his five buffalo, two were missing, he tried to look out of them but could not find. Accordingly FIR was registered.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.
- (7) The Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged buffalo was recovered from the house of the one co-accused and the petitioner name has come up in the confessional statement. He had nothing to do with the theft of the buffalo. He also has a clean antecedent.
- (8) Taking into account the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and nature of allegation and the fact that petitioner is first time offender and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of

communication of this order let the petitioners, namely Md. Shamsheer Kureshi, S/o- Md. Kamruddin @ Mahajan Kureshi be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court subject to the following conditions:-

- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigation agency, as and when required.
- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
