- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Vishal Raj, S/o- Babulal Paswan.
- (2) The petitioner is seeking per-arrest bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS, in Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 158/2026, registered under sections 126(2),115(2),118(1),308(4),324(4),324(5),303(2),3(5) of BNS.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent which is mentioned in para 3 of the bail petition. The entire allegation levelled against the petitioner is false and concocted.
- (5) The case of the informant Naresh Sahni is that on 28.01.2026 around 11 AM, the accused asked for ransom money from his son Sugandh Kumar and Vishal Kumar and on not being given the same his sons were assaulted.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.
- (7) Looking at the nature of allegation against the petitioner and the fact that no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order let the petitioner, namely Vishal Raj, S/o- Babulal Paswan be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court subject to the following conditions:-
