1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused namely, 1. Jitendra Paswan 2. Dharendra Paswan (both sons of Late Kamleshwar Paswan) 3. Deepak Kumar @ Deepak Paswan, S/o- Prakash Paswan.
2. The petitioners are seeking per-arrest bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS, in Maniyari P.S. Case No. 248 of 2013 registered under sections 307,447,341,323,379,504/34 of BNS.
3. Ld. counsel for the petitioners submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have one criminal antecedent i.e. Maniyari P.S. Case no. 82/2023, which is mentioned in para 3 of the bail petition on which they are on bail. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that the allegation levelled against the petitioners are false and concocted.
5. The case of the informant, Jay Chandra Paswan is that on 11.11.2013, while he was sitting outside his house with his family members, the accused came, threatening and assaulting them, they are even alleged to have taken away the jewelry by them.
6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present bail petition.
7. The informant Jay Chandra Paswan is present before the court. He submits that being neighbours a confrontation had taken place but the same has now been amicably settled and they no longer wish to prosecute the matter.
8. In light of the submissions made herein and the fact that no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order let the petitioners, namely 1. Jitendra Paswan 2. Dharendra Paswan (both sons of Late Kamleshwar Paswan) 3. Deepak Kumar @ Deepak Paswan, S/o- Prakash Paswan be
