1. The Petitioner is praying for regular bail in connection with Paroo P. S. Case No. 80/2026 registered for the offences under Section 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 352, 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short). He has been in judicial custody since 13.02.2026.
2. Briefly stated, the precise allegation against the petitioner is that he attempted to assault the injured Ashok Ram on his head by means of kudal with intention to kill, but the said kudal landed on his hand and caused injury thereon. The injured was treated at PHC, Paroo followed by SKMCH, Muzaffarpur.
3. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that he has clean antecedent. He further submits that if the version of the prosecution is taken on its face value, even then it cannot be said that the intention of the petitioner was to kill the injured because alleged injury happened on hands. He further submits that the allegation against the petitioner

is completely false. The petitioner has been in judicial custody for the last three months. In this backdrop, he prays for bail.

4. Heard the parties. Considered the submissions. Perused the material on record including case diary. It appears from the FIR that the petitioner allegedly caused injury on the hands of the injured Ashok Ram (brother of the Informant). Injury report has not been made available by the prosecution. However, the petitioner has been remained in judicial custody for the last three months. The perusal of FIR indicates that the injured sustained injury on his hands.
5. In view of above and further, precisely considering the period of custody undergone by the petitioner coupled with the fact that the part of the body chosen to assault as could be inferred from the FIR itself, I am inclined to enlarge him on bail. In the result, the present petition stands **allowed**.
6. It is ordered that the petitioner namely Gauri Shankar Jamdar @ Shivshankar Jamadar would be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rupees 10,000/- of two sureties each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned.
