1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Guddu Kumar, S/o Rajdev Sahani.

2. The Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 482 of the BNSS apprehending his arrest in Bochahan P.S. Case No. 377/2022, registered under section 379, 414, 413/34 of the IPC.

3. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.

4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he is innocent and has not committed offence as alleged in the F.I.R. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Nothing incriminating article has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case.

5. The case of informant, Priyanka Devi is that on 14.09.2022, around 09:00 AM, when she was plucking vegetables in her field, she received a phone call on mobile phone. Thereafter, she came on the road and during the course of talking, two unknown persons came and snatched a mobile phone and golden Mangal shutra. On her alarm, one person fled away on motorcycle, who has caught by the public and handed over to the police and on being asked, he disclosed his name as Vikash Kumar and also disclosed the name of his associates Guddu Sahni and on being searched by the police, Redmi mobile phone and a gold chain were recovered.

6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.

7. On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that the petitioner was not apprehended on spot and he has been implicated in this case merely on purported statement of co-accused Vikash Kumar. There is no recovery of any incriminating material from direct or conscious possession of this petitioner and as per para no. 3 of anticipatory bail petition, the petitioner has got no criminal history.

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8. Considering the above facts & circumstances and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, the prayer of anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioner namely, **Guddu Kumar, S/o Rajdev Sahani** be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned and subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.
