This application has been filed, on behalf of the accused petitioner in custody, namely, Abhishek Mishra @ Mukul Mishra, for grant of regular bail, in connection with Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 422/2021, registered U/Ss 302, 120(B), 34 of the IPC and 27 of the Arms Act, pending in the Ld. Court of C.J.M., Muzaffarpur.

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner, has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions had been filed on behalf of the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got criminal history of five cases. That the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case, due to enmity. That the petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name has surfaced in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused. That the petitioner was not involved in the alleged murder of the deceased. That the petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 12.01.2026. The petitioner side, prays for his release on bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the original record, including the FIR and case diary, from paras no. 01 to 163. From perusal of the record, it transpires that name of the petitioner has come up in this case in the confessional statement of one co-accused person (CD para no. 29) and allegation against him relates to his direct involvement in conspiracy and murder of the informant's brother, by firing of gun shots, in association with the co-accused persons. There is direct and specific allegation against the petitioner. There is ample incriminating material against the petitioner in the case diary. The allegation is serious in nature and further, the petitioner has got criminal antecedent of five cases.

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Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances of the case, including nature and gravity of the allegations, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, bail application of the accused petitioner, namely, **Abhishek Mishra @ Mukul Mishra**, stands **rejected**.
