This application has been filed, on behalf of the accused petitioner in custody, namely, Dinesh Kumar, for grant of regular bail, in connection with Kudhani P.S. Case No. 25/2026, registered U/Ss 317(5), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 3(5) of the B.N.S., pending in the Ld. court of A.C.J.M. 1st, Muzaffarpur (West).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner, has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions, of any nature had been filed by the the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got no criminal history. That the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case, out of malice grudge and enmity. That the petitioner has committed no offence and nothing has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. That some other co-accused has already been granted regular bail by the court. That the petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 12.02.2026. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the record, including the FIR. From perusal of the record, it transpires that informant of this case is police official and seizure list witnesses are also police officials. As per search and seizure memo, one motorcycle has been recovered from another co-accused person and it has been alleged that said co-accused person had taken that motorcycle from the present petitioner in mortgage. Further, nothing has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. Some other co-accused has already been granted regular bail by the court, from whom the said motorcycle was recovered and case for bail of the petitioner stands on better footing. The petitioner is in judicial custody in this

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26.03.2026 case, since 12.02.2026 and he has got no criminal history.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including period of jail custody, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, bail application of the accused petitioner, namely, **Dinesh Kumar**, stands **allowed** and he is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
