ORDER

Date : 18/06/2026

1. The above named petitioners seeks “Anticipatory Bail” in connection with **Katra P.S. Case No. 54/2026** for offences punishable u/ss 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2)(3), 3(5) of the BNS and due to apprehension of their arrest in this case. Copy of the same has been served to Ld. Addl.P.P. on behalf of State.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case and there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioners. It is further submitted that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possessions of the petitioners. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation of assault surfaced against the petitioners in the F.I.R. Hence, prayed for anticipatory bail.
3. On behalf of, the Ld. A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.
4. The prosecution story in brief of the informant Deepak Kumar is that 27.02.2026 at around 1:30 PM, he was returning home. On the way, at the Bashatta Dam, four accused persons with few unknown persons surround him and they were armed with lathi, sticks and iron rods in their hands, and blocked his way. Dipanshu Kumar @ Aditya snatched the key of his motorcycle and all of them started abusing him and began assaulting him. During the assault, Gokul struck him on his mouth with an iron knuckle duster, causing his mouth to bleed. Meanwhile, Manorath @ Kariya Sah pulled out a pistol from his waist and struck him on the head with the butt of the pistol with the intention to kill him, which fractured his head. Due to severe injuries, he started feeling dizzy, and in the meantime, Dipanshu @ Darshan Sah snatched Rs. 78,000/- from his pocket and a gold ring from his hand. Then the villagers gathered and rescue him.
5. Having considered the submission made by the rival of the parties and from perusal of case record it appears that the petitioners named in the FIR, this anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioners on 18.03.2026 but till yet no case diary along with injury report has to file before the court in spite of several directions to the concern P.S. and last chance had been given on previous dated 09.06.2026. From perusal of F.I.R. and other things it also appears that there is no specific allegations of assault and other things have been found against the victims of the case.

Therefore, I am of the view that the petitioners are deserve to anticipatory bail. Therefore, the anticipatory bail of the petitioners is hereby **allowed**.

6. It is hereby directed that in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within 30 days from the receipt of a copy of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each with satisfaction of the learned trial court.
