- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Shivam Kumar @ Shivam Kumar Paswan, S/o- Laxman Paswan.
- (2) The petitioner is seeking regular bail under section 483 of the BNSS, in Sakra P.S. Case No. 557 of 2025, registered under section 137(2), 96, 3(5) of the BNS.
- (3) The petitioner is in judicial custody since 01.01.2026.
- (4) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (5) Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is false and concocted.
- (6) The case of the informant Rupam Devi is that, on 18.11.2025 around 11 PM, her daughter was kidnapped by Shivam Kumar Paswan. When she went to his house asking about her daughter and said his family-members that her daughter was kidnapped by their son Shivam Kumar Paswan, on which the his family-members started abusing her and threatened to beat her.
- (7) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present bail petition.
- (8) Perused the trial court record including the statement of the victim recorded u/s 183 of the BNSS, wherein she has categorically stated that on 18.11.2025 she left the house around 09:30 PM after having a quarrel with her parents. She went to the railway station, sat on a train and went to Delhi. She was not kidnapped by anybody.
- (9) Taking into account the statement of the victim from which it is evident that the girl left the house without any inducement or enticement by the petitioner herein and went to Delhi on her own and also the fact that no apprehension is shown on

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part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, let the petitioner namely, Shivam Kumar @ Shivam Kumar Paswan, S/o- Laxman Paswan be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to following conditions:

- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigating agency as well as in the trial.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
