1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused 1. Amit Kumar Sah, S/o Late Ajay Sah 2. Ajit Kumar Sah @ Ajit Kumar, S/o Late Ajay Sah and 3. Sanju Devi, W/o Amit Kumar Sah.

2. The Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under section 438 of the Cr.P.C. apprehending their arrest in Bochahan P.S. Case No. 218/2020, registered under section 341, 393, 307, 504, 506/34 IPC.

3. Ld. counsel for the petitioners submit that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.

4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that they are innocent and having dispute between them. That all the sections are bailable except Section 307 IPC which does not attract against them. That the matter has been amicably settled between both the parties. A copy of compromise petition is on record. That petitioners have got no criminal antecedents.

5. The case of the informant, Sadhana Suman is that on 13.08.2020 at 11:00 AM, all the accused persons came and took informant to a place for compromise with respect to prior dispute and that place, all the them assaulted the informant. The allegation against the petitioner relates to having committed marpit with the informant with lathi, danda alongwith accused Sanju Devi and and Sima Devi.

6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.

7. On perusal of the record including the F.I.R., it transpires that F.I.R. in this case has been lodged against five accused persons with common allegation of assault and threatening to kill. Further there is common allegation against the petitioners no. 1 & 2 is that they had dragged the informant by putting rope in her neck with intent to kill her. It appears that this allegation is of ornamental nature. Other allegations are also vague and omnibus. Some co-accused persons have been granted regular bail by the court.

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8. Considering the above facts & circumstances and the nature of allegation against the petitioners, the prayer of anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioners namely, **1. Amit Kumar Sah, S/o Late Ajay Sah 2. Ajit Kumar Sah @ Ajit Kumar, S/o Late Ajay Sah and 3. Sanju Devi, W/o Amit Kumar Sah** be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned and subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.
