- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused 1. Dharmnath Kumar, S/o- Aakaly Sahni.
- (2) The Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS apprehending his arrest in Minapur P.S. Case No. 107 of 2020, registered under sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 342, 323, 324, 307, 302, 504 of IPC.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) Ld. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is false, fabricated and concocted. It is further submitted that several co-accused persons have already been granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide Cr. Misc. No. 3009 of 2021, copy of which is also attached with the record and the case of the present petitioner stands on similar footing.
- (5) The case of the prosecution through informant Pano Devi, is that, on 26.03.2020 around 6 P.M., the accused six in number variously armed with lethal weapons forcefully took her husband on account of a land dispute and assaulted him. He was taken to the hospital wherein he succumbed to his injuries.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.
- (7) Perused the trial court record including the case diary and the postmortem report. The postmortem report mentions that no any antemortem injuries were found either externally or internally. The allegation is against 17 accused persons who have assaulted with weapons.



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(8) Taking into account the prosecution story and the postmortem report which is not in conformity with the prosecution story and no injury found on the body of the deceased and also not being unmindful of the fact that other similarly placed co-accused persons have been granted the benefit of bail and also the fact that petitioner is first time offender and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence or would influence the investigation in any manner, if released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioner namely, 1. Dharmnath Kumar, S/o- Aakaly Sahni be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned, subject to following conditions:-

- The petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the Police officer as and when required.
- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.
