1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Deepa Kumari, D/o Ramesh Kumar.

2. The Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 482 of the BNSS apprehending her arrest in Mithanpura P.S. Case No. 17/2026, registered under section 317(5) BNS.

3. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.

4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that she is innocent and has committed no offence. There is no allegation against the petitioner in the F.I.R. and her name surfaced in confessional statement of main accused.

5. The case of the informant is that on 06.01.2025 around 11 Am, while checking the vehicles, a blue coloured Scooty was seen coming from Sherpur side which on seeing the Police tried to escape. The rider was apprehended by the Police and he disclosed his name as Abhishek Kumar Verma. It was found out that the said Scooty was stolen and was being used by the accused Abhishek Kumar Verma.

6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.

7. On perusal of record including the F.I.R. and case diary paras no. 01 to 52. it appears that present petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. and she has been implicated in this case merely on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Abhishek Kumar (C.D. Para no. 5). The allegation relates to having possession of stolen property. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of present petitioner.

8. Considering the above facts & circumstances and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, the prayer of anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of her arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioner namely, **Deepa Kumari, D/o Ramesh Kumar** be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-

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(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned court concerned and subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482(2) of the BNSS.
