1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused 1. Sajan Kumar, S/o- Sagar Rai.
2. The Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 482 of the BNSS apprehending his arrest in Turki P.S. Case No. 87/2026, registered under section 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 352, 3(5) BNS.
3. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submit that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that he is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged in the F.I.R. That petitioner has got no criminal antecedents. That this case is counter blast of Turki P.S. Case No. 86/2026. The allegation against the petitioner is false and baseless.
5. The case of informant, Baiju Rai is that on 10.03.2026, around 08:00 PM, accused Lalan Kumar started abusing the informant inebriated condition and when he asked about the same, Lalan Kumar started assaulting him with bamboo stick and when his son Divyanshu Kumar came to save, accused Sajan Kumar inflicted iron rod blow upon him causing head injury and fracture injury on nose, due to which his son became unconscious. The informant has further been alleged that all the accused persons pelted stones and bricks on his house and family members. Thereafter, villagers took his son to the hospital for treatment.
6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.
7. On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that the petitioner has assaulted the son of the informant resulting in head and nose injury. However, there is no final injury report attached with the record. There is case and counter

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case between the parties. Other co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail vide ABP No. 1299/2026 by this court.

8. Taking into account the nature of allegation and the fact that no injury report is available on the record and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioner namely, 1. Sajan Kumar, S/o- Sagar Rai be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to following conditions: -

- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigating agency as well as in the trial, as and when required.
- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
