Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that present pre-arrest bail petition is a successive bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner. Anticipatory bail application of the present petitioner had already been rejected by this court as well as by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna.

On the other hand, ld. PP. for the State submits that this petition being a successive bail petition, the petitioner does not deserve the benefit of pre-arrest bail.

In light of the above submissions made by the ld. P.P. and considering the fact that this is a successive anticipatory bail petition, with no change of circumstances made since the earlier petition was rejected, this court is not inclined to grant the benefit of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner named above.

Accordingly, the present anticipatory bail petition of petitioner namely Amarjeet Kumar @ Rajesh Kumar stands rejected.
