- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioners/accused 1. Shivchandra Ram, S/o Late Vijay Ram 2. Vinod Ram, S/o Mahipat Ram and 3 Sonu Kumar, S/o Shivchandra Ram.
- (2) The Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS apprehending their arrest in Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 558/2026 registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 76, 324(4), 324(5), 352, 3(5) BNS.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioners submit that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence. Petitioner has got one criminal antecedent in which he is on bail. Prosecution story is completely false and concocted.
- (5) The case of the informant Minku Kumari is that on 17.03.2026, while she was getting the boundary wall constructed at her land, the accused came and tried to break the wall and when she objected, they misbehaved with her. She also alleges that she was being hit by the accused.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.
- (7) Looking at the nature of allegation and the fact that no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the above named petitioner be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to following conditions:
