- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Bittu Rai, S/o Jilajeet Rai.
- (2) The petitioner is seeking regular bail under section 483 of the BNSS, in Mithanpura P.S. Case No. 320 of 2025, registered under section 303(2) of the BNS.
- (3) The petitioner is in judicial custody since 29.01.2026 in this case.
- (4) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (5) Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence has taken place as alleged in the F.I.R.
- (6) The case of the informant is that on 29.11.2025, around 06:30 PM, he parked his motorcycle outside the house but when he came out, it was stolen. The motorcycle is alleged to have been recovered from possession of the petitioner.
- (7) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present bail petition.
- (8) Taking into account the nature of allegation and the fact that no other similar case is pending against him and no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, let the petitioner namely, Bittu Rai, S/o Jilajeet Rai be released on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned subject to following conditions:

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- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigating agency as well as in the trial, as and when required.
- Petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
