1. The anticipatory bail petition of petitioner, namely Amit Kumar, S/o- Satrudhan Thakur who apprehends his arrest in connection with Ahiyapur PS Case No. 442 of 2026 registered u/ss 447, 419, 506 of IPC has been placed today for hearing.
2. Ld. Counsel for the prosecution at the very outset submits that the sections under which the FIR has been registered, fall under the purview of bailable offences and so, this anticipatory bail petition is not maintainable.
3. However, ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he has been falsely implicated in this case and all the allegations against him are false and fabricated and he further prayed that the petitioner may be given the benefit of pre-arrest bail.
4. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. for the State.
5. On perusal of the record including the FIR, it transpires that the FIR in connection with Ahiyapur PS Case No. 442 of 2026 registered for offences u/ss 447, 419, 506 of IPC is bailable in nature.

Hence, petitioner has no apprehension of arrest in this case and as such, this anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner Amit Kumar, S/o- Satrudhan Thakur stands dismissed as not maintainable.
