

A.B.P No. 1665/2026**Lalu Kumar Yadav.....Petitioner.****Vs.****State of Bihar..... O.P.****ORDER****18.05.2026**

This application has been filed, for grant of anticipatory bail, on behalf of the accused petitioner, namely, Lalu Kumar Yadav, in connection with Benibad P.S. Case No. 43/2024, registered U/Ss 341, 323, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120(B), 504, 506, 34 of the IPC, pending in the Ld. Court of Smt. Sweety Kumari, J.M.F.C., Court No. 13, Muzaffarpur (East).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner, has submitted that earlier petitioner had filed on anticipatory bail application before the court, the same was dismissed as withdrawn and except that petition no other anticipatory or regular bail petitions of any nature had been filed by the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got no criminal history. That the petitioner is quite innocent, has not committed any offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. That the said land was in ownership of Kumar Arunaksh and it was being peacefully occupied by him and on 29.08.2023, he had registered sale deed, in favour of Anita Devi (petitioner's wife) and later on it came to knowledge that Kumar Arunaksh had shown his living father as dead. That there is land dispute between both the parties. It has further been submitted that the petitioner has got genuine apprehension of his arrest in this case. Ld. counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on anticipatory bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the record, including the FIR and case diary, from paras no. 01 to 106. From perusal of the record, it transpires that there is land dispute between the parties. Further, the allegation appears to be related to dispute regarding sale and purchase of land, which is a matter, essentially of civil nature. Prima facie, ingredients of cheating and forgery appear to be missing.

Further, the allegations are omnibus also. Allegations under different sections of the IPC, do not appear to be attracted against the petitioner, in view of material presently available on record.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including allegation of civil nature, the prayer for anticipatory bail, in respect of accused petitioner, named above, is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, the accused petitioner namely, **Lalu Kumar Yadav**, is directed to be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousands) with two sureties of the like amount, subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
