This application has been filed, for grant of anticipatory bail, on behalf of the accused petitioners, namely, (1) Shyawar Sharan Singh and (2) Neha Kumari, in connection with Maniyari P.S. Case No. 61/2026, registered U/Ss 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the B.N.S., pending in the Ld. Court of A.C.J.M. 8th, Muzaffarpur (West).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioners and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioners, has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions of any nature, had been filed by the accused petitioners, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioners have got no criminal history. That the petitioners are quite innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. That one of the petitioners and informant are own brothers/pattidars and there is land dispute between both the parties. That the petitioners were beaten earlier by the informant and the informant's family members and a case for which was lodged by the petitioner no. 02, against the informant and informant's wife as Maniyari P.S. Case No. 224/2021. That the petitioners demand an equal share in the ancestral property from the informant, due to which this false case has been filed by the informant, against the petitioners. It has further been submitted that the petitioners have got genuine apprehension of their arrest in this case. Ld. counsel for the petitioners side, prays for their release on anticipatory bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the record, including the F.I.R. and case diary, from paras no. 01 to 25. From perusal of the record, it transpires that allegations against these petitioners are general and omnibus in nature and no specific allegation has been levelled against them, regarding assault on any vital part of body. Although, there is allegation of assault, but as per the injury report of the informant, there is

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forearm injury and also abrasion. Further, the injury has been found to be simple in nature. As per para no. 03 of the anticipatory bail application, the petitioners have got no criminal history.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, the prayer for anticipatory bail, in respect of the accused petitioners, is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, the accused petitioners, namely, **(1) Shyawar Sharan Singh and (2) Neha Kumari**, are directed to be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousands) with two sureties of the like amount, each, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below and subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
