1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Ranjeet Kumar Sah, S/o Balli Sah. Bail petition was originally filed in the name of petitioner Rajeev Kumar Sah but a supplementary petition was filed on dated 27.04.2026 to the effect that name of the petitioner was mistakenly written as Rajeev Kumar Sah and real name of the petitioner is Ranjeet Kumar Sah.

2. The Petitioner is seeking regular bail under section 439 of the Cr.P.C., in Dewariya P.S. Case No. 231 of 2023, registered under section 147, 307, 341, 323, 324, 325, 504, 506 IPC.

3. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.04.2026.

4. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.

5. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. That the petitioner has got no criminal antecedet. That all alleged offences areailable except Section 307 IPC which does not attract against him. That other co-accused persons have already been granted regular and anticipatory bail.

6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

7. The case of the informant, Sushila Devi, is that, on 02.11.2023 around 7 PM, when she returned home from the market, the accused 8 in numbers, including the petitioner Devendra Sah were present there, abusing her entire family. When she opposed, Ravi Kumar threatened to kidnap her daughter and hit her on the head with the butt of the pistol. The rest accused persons are also alleged to have assaulted her, her daughter and her husband.

8. On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that there is no specific allegation of assault against the petitioner and rather allegation against the petitioner is

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a common and omnibus nature. The specific allegation of assault is against co-accused Ravi Kumar who has been granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide Cr. Misc. No.47713/2024 alongwith co-accused Sita Devi. The co-accused Devendra Sah has also been allowed anticipatory and regular bail vide A.B.P. No.1506/2025 & BP No. 1897/2023 by this court and the case of this petitioner is on similar footing. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.04.2026. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the anticipatory bail application.

9. Considering the above mentioned facts & circumstances, including nature of allegations and the period of jail custody, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is hereby **allowed**. Let the petitioner namely, **Ranjeet Kumar Sah, S/o Balli Sah** be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount, to the satisfaction of Id. Court below.
