1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Sanjeev Kumar, S/o Late Rama Shankar Thakur.

2. The Petitioner is seeking regular bail under section 439 of the Cr.P.C., in Saraiya P.S. Case No. 159 of 2006, registered under section 409, 406, 420, 120(B) IPC.

3. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 17.04.2026.

4. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that he had filed anticipatory bail petition before this court, which was rejected. Thereafter, he filed Cr. Misc. before the Hon'ble High Court which was withdrawn. Except this, no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.

5. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submit that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. That petitioner has got no criminal antecedents. That the petitioner is the son of Bracnh post master and Section 406 and 420 is not make out against him.

6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

7. The allegation against the petitioner is alleged to have misappropriated about Rs. 17 thousand rupees from the several depositors in collusion of his mother, Shakuntala Devi who is Branch Post-mater of Madhaul by making their forged signatures.

8. On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that

9. The allegation against the petitioner is that his mother had misappropriated about 17 thousand rupees, belonging to different senders, received through different payment orders, by forging their signatures and this amount was kept by this petitioner. It has been stated on behalf of the petitioner that some of the intended beneficiaries have already received their money. Investigation is complete and charge-sheet has also been submitted. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 17.04.2026.

9. Considering the above mentioned facts & circumstances, including nature of allegations and the period of jail custody, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is hereby
