1. The Petitioner is praying for regular bail in connection with Saraiya P. S. Case No. 249/2026 registered for the offences under Section 309(4) of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS' for short). He has been in judicial custody since 07.04.2026.
2. Briefly stated, the name of the petitioner has surfaced during the course of investigation in relation to occurrence wherein it is alleged that on 04.04.2026 robbery was caused in CSP on Saraiya Turki path at 11:40 a.m. day. In the said robbery, it is alleged that cash of Rupees 29,300/-, Aadhar Card, driving license, OD check and mobile of the Informant looted. The FIR was lodged against the unknown.
3. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the name of the Petitioner has surfaced on confessional statement of Aman Kumar. He is young fellow and student. He has nothing to do with the present occurrence. He has clean antecedent. In this backdrop, he prays for bail.

4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor does not dispute the fact of clean antecedent being carried by the petitioner. However, he has opposed the prayer so made.
5. Heard the parties. Considered the submissions. Perused the material on record including case diary (attached with TCR). It appears that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. His name has surfaced during the course of investigation. Hence, precisely considering the period of custody coupled with the fact that the petitioner is a first time offender, I am inclined to enlarge him on bail. Accordingly, the present bail petition stands **allowed**.
6. It is ordered that the petitioner namely Mohit Kumar would be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rupees 10,000/- of two sureties each to the satisfaction of learned court concerned. Further, he would file undertaking to the effect that he has no criminal antecedent and in case, it is found, his bail bonds would be liable to be cancelled.
