This application has been filed, on behalf of the accused petitioner in custody, namely, Vishal Kumar @ Vishal Sahni, for grant of regular bail, in connection with Minapur P.S. Case No. 265/2020, registered U/Ss 414, 420, 467, 468, 471, 472, 120(B), 34 of the IPC and 25(1-B)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act, pending in the Ld. Court of Sri Siddharth Sharma, J.M.F.C., Court No. 08 Muzaffarpur (East).

Heard arguments of Ld. Counsel, appearing for the accused petitioner and Ld. A.P.P. for the State.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner has submitted that previously no anticipatory or regular bail petitions of any nature had been filed by the the accused petitioner, either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. That the petitioner has got no criminal history. That the petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. That the entire allegations as levelled against the petitioner are false and fabricated. That no incriminating articles have been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. That the petitioner has been remanded in this case, from another case. That some other co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail, by the court and case for bail of the petitioner stands on better footing. That the petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 11.03.2026. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner side, prays for his release on bail.

Ld. A.P.P. for the state, opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the original record, including the FIR and case diary, from paras no. 01 to 108. From perusal of the record, it transpires that allegations against the petitioner are general, common, vague and omnibus in nature. No any specific allegation has been levelled against the petitioner and no any specific overt act has been attributed to him. Petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name has surfaced in this case, on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused, namely, Mithun Kumar (as mentioned in CD para no. 40). No any

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arms or ammunition have been recovered from possession of this petitioner. Some other co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail by the court and case for bail of the petitioner stands on similar footing. The petitioner is in judicial custody, in this case, since 11.03.2026.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, including period of jail custody, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, bail application of the accused petitioner, namely, **Vishal Kumar @ Vishal Sahni**, stands **allowed** and he is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below. Let a copy of this order be sent to the court concerned, for needful.
