1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Md. Siraj @ Siraj Ansari @ Siraj Alam, S/o Md. Usman.

2. The Petitioner is seeking regular bail under section 439 of the Cr.P.C., in Mithanpura P.S. Case No. 184 of 2017, registered under section 25(1-B)a, 26, 35 of Arms Act.

3. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 15.04.2026 as per para 4 of bail application.

4. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that he had filed ABP No. 986/2026 which was dismissed as not maintainable. Except this, no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.

5. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submit that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. That petitioner has got no criminal antecedents. That entire allegations as alleged in the F.I.R. is false and concocted. That nothing incriminating has been recovered from his possession. That petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. rather his name has cropped up in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused.

6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

7. Prosecution case in brief is that on 12.06.2017, around 21:15 hrs., while the informant (A.S.I. Raju Kumar Singh) was on patrolling duty, he received an information that a white color car carrying four people including the driver was being driven away rashly and negligently by dashing the people. To verify the same, the informant indicated to stop the car near Pani Tanki Chowk and caught the driver whereas three persons managed to escape from there. The apprehended person disclosed his name as Amresh Kumar and he also disclosed the name of his associates as Seraj Alam, Ritik and Indian. On being searched, one loaded country made pistol was recovered from

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possession of accused Amresh Kumar. Accordingly, seizure list was prepared and F.I.R. was lodged.

8. On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that petitioner was not apprehended on spot and he has been implicated in this case merely on the basis of purported statement of the apprehended accused person. No incriminating material has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 15.04.2026, as per para 04 of bail application. Informant of this case is a police official.

9. Considering the above mentioned facts & circumstances, including nature of allegations and the period of jail custody, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is hereby **allowed**. Let the petitioner namely, **Md. Siraj @ Siraj Ansari @ Siraj Alam, S/o Md. Usman** be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of Id. Court below.
