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ORDER

1. The bail petition filed on behalf of the custody accused namely ***Md. Mayur***, who is in judicial custody since **23.03.2026** in connection with **Town P.S. Case No. 205/2026, dated 22.03.2026** registered **u/s 190, 115(2), 126(2), 76, 324(4), 324(5), 109 of the B.N.S.** praying therein to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Copy of the same supplied to the State.
2. Heard the Ld. counsel for the petitioner and the Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State.
3. The prosecution case is that on 22.03.2026 at about 5:30 p.m in the evening Lakki Khan and Mayur (petitioner) forcibly entered into the informant's house. The accused persons torn the wearing clothes of her daughter Yashmin Parveen and tried to outrage her modesty. On hearing screaming of her daughter, She went there and saw her daughter's clothes were torn and Lakki Khan was doing forcible act with her daughter and he beaten her on her chest and pulled her hair and also gave leg blow on her private part due to which she started bleeding. Informant tried to save her then she was also put on ground and when she cried then Ravi Shankar Prasad and Hritik came there, her son Md. Mehfuji and his friend Md. Arif also came to save her daughter upon which Lakki Khan made call and called his criminal

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associates and also threatened to sell their grand-daughters. Accused Sadique Khan having rod in his hand with Ravi Shankar and he got injured behind his ears and stomach. Accused Sarfuddin @ Chiku having rod in his hand and knife injured Md. Mahfuj on his head. Accused Faij Khan, Miku Khan, Sohail Khan, Rahul Sahni, Sumit Kumar, Ismail Khan, Farhan Khan and Irshad Ali. They entered into her house, beaten them and thrown stone and bricks due to which they become injured and articles in the house got broken and thereafter, injureds were taken to hospital for treatment.

4. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case by the informant only to harass, humiliate and extort him. The Ld. Counsel further submitted that Town P.S. Case No. 205/2026, dated 22.03.2026 u/s 190, 115(2), 126(2), 76, 324(4), 324(5), 109 of the B.N.S. was registered against the petitioner and others. The entire allegations as alleged in this case against the petitioner are false and fabricated. Nothing incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The allegations against the petitioner are general and omnibus. All the Sections areailable except 76 and 109 of the B.N.S. which are not applicable against the petitioner. The co-accused of this case has already been granted bail by the District & Additional Sessions Judge-VIII, Muzaffarpur vide B.P. No. 549/2026 and B.P. No. 577/2026 namely Md. Ismail Khan and Lucky Khan and petitioner case also stands on same footing. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.03.2026 without any rhyme and reason .On these grounds, the prayer for bail is made.

5. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

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6. Heard respective submissions of the learned Counsels. Petitioner is having clean antecedent and he is in custody since 23.03.2026. It is stated the other co-accused namely Md. Ismail Khan and Lucky Khan granted bail. The case of this petitioner is on better footing. I gone through the F.I.R., there is no direct allegation against this petitioner. The persons against whom allegation of beating was mentioned has been granted bail.
7. Hence, in view of clean antecedent and period of custody as well as role of this petitioner, the present regular bail petition of the petitioner is hereby ***allowed***. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand rupees only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court with subject to condition that petitioner shall co-operate in investigation and remain physically present during the trial.
