- (1) Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused 1. Chandan Kumar, S/o- Harendra Rai.
- (2) The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 482(2) of the BNSS, in Saraiya P.S. Case No. 311 of 2017, registered under sections 385, 387 of the IPC.
- (3) Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.
- (4) The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent vide Saraiya PS Case No. 310/2017. The entire allegation levelled against the petitioner is false and concocted.
- (5) The case of the informant Kedar Nath Sah, is that, on 17.08.2017 he was sitting in his jewelry shop as usual. Around 4:25 PM, he received a call on his mobile number and the accused caller was claiming to be an Area Commander of Azad Hind Fauj who demanded Rs. 5 lakh as extortion. The informant further alleged that on refusal of the said amount, the accused threatened to kill him including his two sons.
- (6) The learned P.P. for the state opposed the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner.
- (7) On perusal of the record, it is evident that petitioner is not the named accused of the FIR. Neither the phone nor the sim card used in the present case has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner. Other co-accused persons have already been granted regular bail by the court of Id. AS-6th Muzaffarpur. The case of the present petitioner stands on better footing.

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(8) Taking into account the nature of allegation against the petitioner and the fact that no apprehension is shown on part of the prosecution that the accused would flee from justice or commit a similar offence, if released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the petitioner 1. Chandan Kumar, S/o- Harendra Rai be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court subject to the following conditions:-

- The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigating agency as well as trial.
- The petitioner shall not commit an offence in future.
- The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
- The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence-witness in any manner.
