1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Sonu Kumar, S/o Kameshwar Das.

2. The Petitioner is seeking regular bail under section 483 of the BNSS, in Dewariya P.S. Case No. 83 of 2026, registered under section 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 351(2), 3(5) BNS.

3. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 02.04.2026.

4. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.

5. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. That the petitioner has got one criminal antecedent in which he is on bail. That all the offences are bailable except Section 118(1) and 109 of the BNS. That the matter has been amicably settled between the parties as parties have entered into compromise.

6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

7. The case of the informant Amit Kumar Das, is that, on 20.03.2026 around 8 AM, the accused Kameshwar Das, Sonu Kumar and Mamta Devi were hitting the informant's grand mother and when he went to her rescue, he was assaulted by Kameshwar Das and Sonu Kumar.

8. On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that allegation of assault by spade upon the informant is not specific against this petitioner. Other allegations against this petitioner are also vague and omnibus. There appears to be previous enmity between the parties and the petitioner is in judicial custody since 02.04.2026.

9. Considering the above mentioned facts & circumstances, including nature of allegations and the period of jail custody, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is hereby **allowed**. Let the petitioner namely, **Sonu Kumar, S/o Kameshwar Das** be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like

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amount each to the satisfaction of Id. Court below and subject to the conditions, as laid down u/s 480(3) of the BNSS.
