ORDER

02.06.2026. Instant application for grant of bail has been filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioner who has been in custody since 30.03.2026 in connection with Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 123/2025, registered u/Ss 109, 352, 351(3), 3(5) of B.N.S. & 27 of Arms Act.

Heard Mr. Shyam Kishore, learned advocate for the accused/petitioner and Ms. Sangita Sahi, learned Addl. P.P. for the State.

F.I.R. has been registered against unknown.

Prosecution case, in brief, is that at about 5:50 a.m. on 17.03.2025, two criminals came at informant's house and indiscriminately fired bullets and then returned on their bikes.

It has been alleged in the F.I.R. that criminals had come in order to kill informant and his family members.

Learned Advocate for the accused/petitioner has submitted that accused/petitioner is quite innocent and he has been falsely implicated due to previous enmity and grudge. Besides this case, accused/petitioner is also accused in Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 574/2024 and no bail application has been filed earlier on his behalf before either this court or the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. It has been further submitted that accused/petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. and his implication is based solely on the confession of co-accused namely Kundan Kumar @ Kundan Bhagat. Accused/petitioner has not been arrested at the spot and no incriminating articles have been recovered from his possession and police has got no T.I.P. conducted. Furthermore, accused/petitioner was working at Likhita infrastructure Limited Kuch Bihar W.B. from before and he has been in judicial custody since 30.03.2026. So, he may be granted regular bail.

On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the accused/petitioner.

Perused the certified copy of F.I.R., copy of case diary and trial court record as well as record of S.Tr. No.- 672/2025.

Having heard learned from both sides and perused the documents mentioned above, this court finds that the name of this accused/petitioner has transpired in the confessional statement of co-accused Kundan Kumar and

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Contd..... thereafter, his confession has been recorded and there is nothing except confession
02.06.2026 in the entire case diary against the accused/petitioner who has been in custody since 30.03.2026. This court also finds that no member of informant's family has received any injury in the alleged occurrence.

So, considering the nature of allegation against the accused/petitioner in the F.I.R. and other facts discussed above, this court is inclined to grant accused/petitioner bail.

Accordingly, he is directed to be released on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount subject to the condition that one of whom must be his family member who shall state on affidavit his/her relationship with the accused/petitioner.

Accordingly, his regular bail petition is hereby **allowed**.
