1. Heard, learned P.P. for the State and the learned Counsel on behalf of the petitioner/accused Anil Sahani @ Anil Kumar, S/o Shambhu Sahani.

2. The Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under section 438 of the Cr.P.C. apprehending his arrest in Kanti P.S. Case No. 388/2017, registered under section 379, 411 IPC.

3. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that no other bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been previously moved before this court or the Hon'ble High Court.

4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he is innocent and has committed no offence as alleged in the F.I.R. That petitioner has got no criminal antecedents. Nothing incriminating materials have been recovered from possession of the petitioner.

5. The case of informant, Awadhesh Sahani is that on 26.09.2017, around 08:30 PM, he was going to his relative and when he stopped his motorcycle at Paharpur Bandh, two miscreants riding on a Pulsar motorcycle pushed him down and thereafter, one person took away his motorcycle and another was fled away by Pulsar motorcycle. While they are running away, the informant identified them as Dipak Sahani and Anil Sahani.

6. The learned P.P. for the state opposed the present anticipatory bail petition.

7. On perusal of record including the F.I.R., it appears that only allegation against the petitioner is that he was following the prime accused by a different Pulsar vehicle. Allegation of theft is not against the present petitioner. Allegations against the present petitioner are omnibus and prima facie allegations of offences under section 379, 411 IPC are not attracted against the present petitioner.

8. Considering the above facts & circumstances and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, the prayer of anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court concerned within four weeks from the

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date of communication of this order, let the petitioner namely, **Anil Sahani @ Anil Kumar, S/o Shambhu Sahani** be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned court concerned.
